If you have multiple users on one Plesk account and need to FTP content without editing the FTP password, you can retrieve the password from MySQL. To Retrieve a Plesk Password From MySQL Log in as root in SSH. Type `mysql -uadmin -p`cat /etc/psa/.psa.shadow``, and then press **Enter**. Type `use psa;`, and then press **Enter**. Type `select * from sys_users;`, and then press **Enter**. Type `select * from accounts where id = 2;`, and then press **Enter**.
