Inside and outside interfaces allow for the creation and modification of firewall access rules. To Configure Cisco PIX 501 Interfaces In a Web browser, navigate to: [https://\[your firewall management IP address\]](https://[your firewall management IP address]) You may receive a number of security certificate warnings. If you accept the certs and save them as "Trusted," you will avoid warnings in the future. Enter your **User name** and **Password**, and then click **OK**. **NOTE:** Your browser must have Java enabled and allow pop-ups from your firewall management IP. In the **Device Manager** application tool bar, click the **Configuration** icon. Click the **System Properties** tab. In the tree on the left, click **Interfaces**. In the **Interfaces** panel, click the interface you want to edit. Click **Edit**. Configure the interface and click **OK**. Click **Apply**. **NOTE:** If you do not click **Apply**, you will be prompted to apply changes the next time you view access rules.
