Your firewall will automatically map incoming requests on your external IP addresses to your internal (10.x.x.x) addresses. Web Sites When setting up domains within Simple Control Panel, be sure to associate your domains with the internal (10.x.x.x) IP addresses for your server. During the domain setup wizard, you will be presented a dropdown list of all IP addresses that exist on the box. When you select the appropriate address, your firewall will automatically map incoming requests on your external IP addresses to your internal (10.x.x.x) addresses.
