Copying and Pasting Attachments To add a file as an attachment to your message, copy the file from your computer and paste it into your Web-Based Email Compose window. The file name displays in the Attachments list. Copying and Pasting Content and Images Open the file that contains the content and images you want to include in the body of your message, and then copy and paste the content, including images, into the body of your message. The content, including the images, displays in the body of your message.
