Sell single items or "lots" containing multiple items (e.g. a dining set or patio furniture). An individual item is a single item. A lot is a grouping of items into a single item for sale, with each lot containing multiple items sold as a group. Place a counter on your **Item Listing** page to know the number of times (hits) your listing has been viewed. A counter is a great way to measure observe shopper interest for your items. Lot Listing You can sell similar items together in one listing to one buyer (a case of shaving razors, a record collection, etc.). For example, if you have 50 hammers that you'd like to sell together to one buyer for an average price of \$5.99 each. To list these hammers as a "lot," you would first click the **Lot** tab in the **Quantity** section, and enter "1" in the **Number of Lots** box and "50" in the **Number of Items Per Lot** box. You would then set the price to \$299.50. The winning bidder will win all 50 hammers.
