Our Windows hosting accounts allow you to set up Access database support. Using the Hosting Control Center, you can automatically create an "access_db" directory where you can upload your access database files. To Set up an Access Database for Your Web Site Log in to your [Account Manager](#). In the **My Products** section, select **Hosting Account List**. Next to the hosting account you want to modify, click **Open**. In the **Databases** section of the Hosting Control Center, click the **Access** icon. Click **Enable Access Support**. This creates a private directory in your hosting directory called "access_db." This directory will already have the appropriate database permissions set. Once you enable Access database support by creating this directory, upload your Access database file to the "access_db" directory. The permissions on this directory allow anonymous Web users to read and write to the Access database through your scripts, but they cannot download your database. **NOTE:** Your Access database file will generally have an ".mdb" file extension.
